

## **Moving home? Make sure you stay licensed!**

If you are moving out of halls or other student accommodation, remember that your TV Licence does not move with you and you'll need to notify TV Licensing of your new address in order to remain licensed.

Make sure you update your address details by visiting [www.tvlicensing.co.uk/students2008](http://www.tvlicensing.co.uk/students2008) and following the instructions. It only takes a minute or two. You'll be asked for your TV Licence number and new address.

If you are moving later in the summer, you can update your details up to 90 days in advance. And, if you don't yet know your new address, you can sign up for the email reminder service, and TV Licensing will contact you at the appropriate time to make sure you remain correctly licensed.

At the same time you can choose to receive your TV Licence by email instead of receiving a paper licence in the post.

TV Licensing is also reminding students that they could be eligible for a refund on the final three months of their licence if they are not staying at university over the summer. Students who bought their TV Licence in October and don't need it for July, August and September, may be able to claim back the final quarter of their licence. The refund on a TV Licence bought in October 2007 will be £33.88.

If you use television-receiving equipment without a valid TV Licence, you risk prosecution and a fine of up to £1,000, plus court costs, and you will need to buy a TV Licence if you still need one. A colour licence costs £139.50.
